

No Tech for Apartheid Memory Archiving – Oral Histories of Google Worker Organizing

Recruitment strategy

The PI will be sending a direct message via Signal to current and former Google workers currently based in NY who are involved in NOTA organizing efforts and have previously agreed to be spokespeople for NOTA press. The message will include information about the project and include a link to a short recruitment questionnaire to be filled out by those who are interested for screening purposes.

The PI will go through the responses to the recruitment questionnaire, and will set up meetings with subjects to discuss the project further. Participants who agree to move forward will be sent informed consent and release forms, and will coordinate with the PI to schedule in-person interviews.
